THE SECOND ERRATUM FOR THE PUBLIC NOTICE N°01/POSFIL/2018 - SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE GRADUATE PROGRAM IN PHILOSOPHY (PPGFIL) OF UFSC – MASTER AND DOCTORAL DEGREE IN PHILOSOPHY

The Coordination of the Graduate Program in Philosophy, of the Federal University of Santa Catarina, in the use of its legal attributions, makes public the present rectification of the call for applications N°01/POSFIL/2018 - Selective Process for Masters and Doctoral degree in Philosophy, for admission in March of 2019, in the paragraph that informs the period to verify the self-declaration of the candidates with disabilities and of the black (black and brown) and indigenous candidates.

Where it reads:

“During the period from 19 to 26 October, on a date, time and place to be published on the PPGFIL website, the self-declared black (black or brown) candidates and indigenous candidates must present themselves to the respective Commission appointed by the Secretariat for Affirmative Actions and Diversities (SAAD) to verify self-declaration. Candidates with disabilities may be asked to present themselves, during this period, if there is a need for completing documentation or evaluation.

Candidates who do not prove the requirements regarding the modality in which they have been classified may still have their registration approved, although they are no longer eligible for the indicated priority grant. Candidates who provide false information regarding the requirements established by the UFSC Normative Resolution will be subject to penalties for crimes provided by law.”

Read:

“During the **period from October 29, 2018 to November 1, 2018**, on a date, time and place to be published on the PPGFIL website, self-declared black (black or brown) candidates and indigenous candidates must present themselves to the appropriate committee appointed by Secretariat for Affirmative Action and Diversity (SAAD) for the verification of self-declaration. Candidates with disabilities may be required to attend during this period if there is a need for completing documentation or evaluation. **The self-declarations of foreign candidates will be verified by the Master and**

Doctoral Selection Committees. The result will be posted on the PPGFIL website until 5:00 pm on November 1, 2018.

Candidates who do not prove the requirements regarding the modality in which they have been classified may still have their registration approved, although they are no longer eligible for the indicated priority grant. Candidates who provide false information regarding the requirements established by the UFSC Normative Resolution will be subject to penalties for crimes provided by law.”

The aforementioned rectification begins to have this new wording, remaining unchanged the other items and subitems of the Call For Applications N° 01/POSFIL/2018.
